BIOGRAPHY

Prof. Remo Susanna Jr is Professor of Ophthalmology and Chair of Department of Ophthalmology of the University of São Paulo. Prof Remo has authored 37 book chapters, and 12 books primarily in the field of glaucoma. He has created the early Diagnose Program (EDP), considered one of the best way to detect glaucoma by the European glaucoma experts and has been being part of several teaching program in the World (FORGE in USA). He has conducted more than 100 clinical trials. Latest he is investigating the role of IOP spikes in glaucoma progression and how to detect it. He has given more than 600 lectures on glaucoma.

He was member of the Board of Governors, Past-President, World Glaucoma Association, founder and Past President, Latin American Glaucoma Society, past president of Pan American Glaucoma Society and Brazilian glaucoma Society, member of International Committee, ARVO, reviewer of the most important journals in ophthalmology such as American J Ophthalmology, Ophthalmology, Archives of Ophthalmology, British J Ophthalmology etc.
